A Comedy of Tenors by Ken Ludwig

Directed by Michael Gareau - September 17th to 28th 2019

One hotel suite, four tenors, two wives, three girlfriends, and a soccer stadium filled with screaming fans. What could possibly go wrong? It's 1930s Paris and the stage is set for the concert of the century – as long as producer Henry Saunders can keep Italian superstar Tito Merelli and his hot-blooded wife, Maira, from causing runaway chaos. Prepare for an uproarious ride, full of mistaken identities, bedroom hijinks, and madcap delight.

Operation: Mincemeat by Simon Corble

Directed by Andrew Williams - November 5th to 16th 2019

"Operation: Mincemeat", a thrilling wartime adventure, dramatizes one of the most successful strategic deceptions in the history of war. With North Africa on the brink of being won back from Rommel, two clever chaps in British Naval Intelligence were given the task of inventing a deception that would make the Nazis believe the Allies' next goal was to liberate Greece and Sardinia (and not the blindingly-obvious Sicily). This charming and smart production draws on both historical records and semi-fictional accounts, to weave a tense and dramatic tale.

The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time by Simon Stephens

Directed by Sandy Wynne- February 4th to 15th 2020

15-year-old Christopher has an extraordinary brain: He is exceptional at mathematics but ill-equipped to interpret everyday life. He has never ventured alone beyond the end of his road, he detests being touched, and he distrusts strangers. Now it is 7 minutes after midnight, and Christopher stands beside his neighbor's dead dog, Wellington, who has been speared with a garden fork. Finding himself under suspicion, Christopher is determined to solve the mystery of who murdered Wellington, and he carefully records each fact of the crime. But his detective work, forbidden by his father, takes him on a thrilling journey that upturns his world.

Quartet by Ronald Harwood

Directed by Barbara Kopolak - March 24th to April 4th 2020

Cecily, Reggie and Wilfred reside in a home for retired opera singers in Kent, England. Each year, on the tenth of October, there is a concert to celebrate Verdi's birthday. Jean, who used to be married to Reggie, arrives at the home and disrupts their equilibrium. She still acts like a diva and refuses to sing. But the show must go on in this funny and poignant play.

Opening Night by Norm Foster

Directed by Brian McManus - May 12th to 23rd 2020

This early Norm Foster presents familiar characters we come to love. In this sitcom we meet a couple of empty nesters, a couple of almost nesters and some aspiring and aging actors on opening night of a melodrama. As the story twists and turns we see their hopes and dreams, fears and failings play out. The evening is a wonderful romp that treats the audience to hilarious comedy and tender moments.
